

What is the WA Seniors Card Discount Directory?

A complete list of discounts and Government concessions is available in the WA Seniors Card Discount Directory, which is updated every two years, and sent to all Seniors Card members.

The WA Seniors Card Discount Directory lists 500 businesses across the State that offer discounts of 10 per cent or more, or at least \$20 off the cost of the services and products on offer.

New discounts are added frequently and card holders can check these out online at the Seniors Card website at:

WA Seniors Card

If you are a new WA Seniors Card holder or have had a card for many years, you may not be aware of the full range of benefits you are entitled to.

As a WA Seniors Card holder, you can access up to \$1,200 worth of benefits and concessions a year.

These benefits range from State Government concessions on local government and water rates, energy supply charges, free travel on public transport and discounts on car and fishing licences, just to name a few.

In addition, you can obtain hundreds of discounts from private businesses on a wide range of goods and services.



What are some of the most popular state government concessions I can access?

Concession	Approximate Value
Water service charges – up to 25% discount	\$245 (capped maximum 2011–2012)
Local Government Rates - up to 25% discount*	\$257 (capped maximum 2011-2012)
Emergency Services levy - up to 25% discount*	\$70 (based on maximum 2011-2012 charge)
* These amounts are generally combined on your rates notice	
Energy Supply Charge Rebate - 100% discount	\$147 (2011-2012 year)
Fishing licences - 50% discount	\$83 (based on applying for all licences)
Free Transperth public travel	\$83 (based on average use 2011-12)
Transwa travel - 50% discount	\$81 (based on a return trip to Kalgoorlie)
Motor driver's licence renewal	\$58 (saving on 5 year licence)
Spectacles subsidy	\$50 (available every 2 years)
WA National Parks entry and camping annual pass	\$30 (based on annual pass)

As a card holder, you are also entitled to a State Government rebate to assist with your living expenses and a one-off rebate for the purchase or installation of home security and fire safety devices, to help you feel safe in your own home.

Cost of Living Rebate	\$150.00 (single) (in 2011) \$225.00 (couple) (in 2011)
Security Rebate	up to \$200 (for the purchase or installation of approved security devices)
Electrical and Fire Safety Rebate	up to \$200 (for the purchase or installation of electrical and fire safety devices)

As part of the National Seniors Transport scheme, WA Seniors Card holders can also access concession fares on public transport when travelling throughout Australia - another great way to enjoy the benefits of your card even when you are away from home.
